On day of hire you will be issued with a personalised copy of this document to sign, which will be retained by Jump for Joy Moray for our records. After the booking you will be emailed a copy of the signed documents for your records.

Jump For Joy Moray accept no responsibility for damage or injury whilst our equipment is under hire to you:

- Once the inflatable is set up by the hire company, the hirer is solely responsible for the safe operation of the bouncy castle, they must ensure that all possible steps are taken to avoid injury or damage to the equipment.
- Bouncy castles are to be supervised by someone over the age of 18 years old, strictly no more than six people on the castle at any one time.
- Under no circumstance can food or drink be consumed on the bouncy castle, any food or drink stains or marks on the inflatable will result in a cleaning charge.
- Shoes, jewellery, keys, lighters, or sharp objects are strictly prohibited on the bouncy castle.
- No face paint is permitted on the inflatable, some face paint can stain the bouncy castle. If face paint stains the bouncy castle a cleaning charge or even replacement charge may be applied
- Any damages that occur during the hire are the responsibility of the hirer listed above, any damages may be charged up to the value of replacing a whole new unit.
- Any missing items at time of collection will be subject to a charge of replacing the missing unit, the hirer listed above will be responsible for any charges. Any missing items from a set may be subject to a charge of replacing the full set of items.
- All units will be checked on delivery of any cleanliness issues, we will clean at location if units get dirty during set up. In signing the document, you agree that the units are clean and in good working order.
- Only employees of Jump for Joy Moray are authorised to collect the equipment, equipment shouldn't be handed over to anyone who is not a Jump for Joy Employee. If you have any concerns, please contact us immediately.
- The hirer listed above is solely responsible for any injury or damage that occurs whilst the equipment is in the care of the hirer. Always remember to be safe and have fun.
- All bookings can be cancelled or transferred up to 3 weeks before the booking without the loss of deposit, after 3 weeks the deposit will be retained but, in case of cancellation, you can transfer you booking to a different date within 6 months of the original hire date. Bookings may only be transferred once. Any transferred booking must be to the same value or more.

ADULT BOUNCY CASTLE RULES AND SAFETY GUIDELINES

The below are rules of play and safety guidelines to ensure that you have an enjoyable and safe experience while hiring the adult bouncy castle. Please ensure that you have read the below carefully and fully. By signing the terms and conditions you are accepting liability for any damaged or missing items as well as any injuries that may occur. The hire company does not accept any responsibility for missing or damaged items or any injuries that may occur.

The hirer named in the above document must ensure the following:

- No overcrowding of the equipment, you should limit the number of children on the equipment based upon the size of the children or adults using it. The hire company accepts no responsibility for any damage or injury.
- Avoid, where possible, having too many older children and younger children on the bouncy castle at the same time, this will help prevent accidental injury of a younger child. The hire company accepts no responsibility for any damage or injury.
- To avoid small children falling from entry/exit points, always help them on/off bouncy castle to prevent injury.
- Do not climb on side walls of bouncy castle. This could cause injury to children or damage to the side walls of the bouncy castle.
- Please note anyone with a medical condition or history of back and neck problems are strictly not permitted on the bouncy castle, at any time.
- Under no circumstances are safety mats to be removed from the side of entry/exit points. No pegs/sandbags to be tampered with.
- Blower, straps, and power cables must not be touched unless to deflate bouncy castle in event of poor weather/emergency. These areas should be kept clear of. Be aware of air outlet strap at rear of castle and ensure that it does not come loose.
- Please ensure socks are strictly worn for hygiene reasons. If someone accidentally enters bouncy castle without socks, please make the collection driver aware. Extra cleaning must take place.
- Please note face paints are not permitted on the bouncy castle as this can stain the inflatable, if a child accidentally enters with face paint of, please wipe clean immediately. If inflatable is returned with face paint on it a cleaning or replacement charge may be chargeable to the hirer as named on this document.
- Children and adults should avoid wrestling, purposely banging into each other, and jumping on each other to reduce risk of injury.
- No food or drink is permitted on the bouncy castle at any time.
- No shoes are permitted on the bouncy castle at any time.
- No Jewellery or sharp objects are permitted on the bouncy castle at any time.
- No Lighters or flammable items are permitted on or near the bouncy.
- Inflatables cannot be used outdoor in wind gust speeds of 20mph or above. In event of high wind speeds, inflatable must be deflated.
- In event of heavy rain inflatable must be deflated and if possible covered. Occasional light shower is acceptable, but slippery conditions can cause injury, therefore steps must be taken to dry bouncy castle before using again.

All our bouncy castles are designed and manufactured in Britain to British Standards and the above guidelines must be followed to ensure safe and enjoyable fun at your event.
